



RE-ENTRY PLAN AT A GLANCE

OMSD strives to be as **FLEXIBLE** as possible for families during the current health crisis. All of our campuses will employ blended learning. Your child will be able to attend school in the traditional fashion as often as you wish. Alternately, you may choose to keep your child at home some or all of the time. The choice is up to you! Each child will be issued a Chromebook that they will be responsible for taking to and from school each day. Each child will have a log in to their curriculum.

FACE COVERINGS

- Face coverings are recommended for staff and students in grades 4-12. Grades K-3 are also encouraged to wear a facial covering. They will not be required during recess, meal time, or whenever proper distancing is possible.
- Face masks are strongly recommended to all students riding a school bus.
- OMSD has purchased 3 washable face coverings for all students grades 4-12 and all staff. We will launder them at the school. This way no student will be without a mask at school. You are welcome to purchase face coverings for your child and send them.

HEALTH PROTOCOL

- Any person exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be sent to the nurse for evaluation.
- A separate space will be set up for any person with COVID 19 symptoms. Any student or employee with symptoms of COVID 19 will be sent home.
- Parents must keep their child at home if they exhibit the following symptoms or have been in direct contact with someone who has tested positive.
 - * Fever of 100.4 * Cough * Headache
 - * Shortness of breath * Sore throat * Fatigue
 - * Loss of taste or smell * Difficulty breathing

VISITORS

- Visitors will not be allowed on campus without a prior appointment.
- Visitors will not be allowed in hallways or in classrooms.
- Kindergarten teachers will contact all families to schedule a time before school starts to meet the parents and students, drop off supplies, etc. Parents will not be allowed inside the school on the first day of classes.

TRANSPORTATION

- Buses will be disinfected after each route
- Masks are strongly recommended to be worn on school buses as distancing is not possible
- Hand Sanitizer will be provided on all buses
- A seating chart will be created by each driver; students must sit in their assigned seat.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCH

- All students will pick up a grab and go breakfast from the cafeteria and take that to their homeroom to eat.
- Lunch will be served in the cafeteria with staggered schedules and physical distancing.
- Students who work from home will be able to receive a school lunch. Parent will need to let the school know by 9am if you plan to come pick up lunch for your child/children that day.

OMSD has appointed St. Joe school nurse, Ariel Kelley, as our district Point of Contact for COVID-19. Ariel will be the person you can contact with health related questions or concerns.
