

OMSD DISTRICT PLAN OF SUPPORT

1. Ensure continuity of teaching and learning by providing a guaranteed and viable curriculum that includes both in person and digital learning (K-12) and diagnostic assessments (K-8)
 - **Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum** As always, our teachers will be the primary curriculum. They have written units of study and created common formative assessments based on the identified essential standards. As an additional resource, our district used ESSR funds to purchase Amplify reading curriculum K-6 and Savvas curriculum for K-11 math, 3-12 Science, and 4-12 Social Studies. As an additional resource for our digital program, we have elected to use the Lincoln Learning curriculum provided by the state.
 - **To be delivered any time/any place** We have opted to use the Buzz LMS for our district digital program, while our traditional students will use Google Classroom. These digital platforms allow our students and teachers to access their curriculum any time and any place.
 - **Diagnostic Assessments (K-8)** OMSD will utilize the STAR testing provided by the state.
2. Ensure that unfinished learning is addressed from the prior year.
 - **Unfinished Learning** In addition to STAR testing, we purchased Successmaker math diagnostic assessments. Teachers across the district have access to the Academic Playbook to help them provide the missed skills from the previous year.
 - **Response to Intervention** OMSD has had a 3-tiered RTI model in place for several years. We will continue to focus on Tier 1 quality classroom instruction. Students who are found to be “at risk” for falling below grade level in content area skills will be transitioned to Tier 2 small group instruction. Finally, any student who continues to struggle academically while still receiving Tier 2 instruction, will be transitioned to Tier 3 one on one remediation.
3. Utilize a Learning Management System
 - Google Classroom will be used for traditional students and Buzz will be utilized for digital learning students.
4. Schedule Teacher Training for how to use the LMS
 - **Will you bring teachers together by grade/content for planning?** Teachers met during the week of July 20, 2021 to to learn more about PLC/RTI in their schools. Solution Tree provided professional development for all teachers in our district.
5. Use effective technology for parents and students
 - OMSD has worked to determine connectivity and device needs for each family. We are providing mobile hotspots for those in need, Chromebooks or laptops for every student, training on how to use the LMS, and finally offline PDFs for families with no opportunity for cellular service.
6. Provide a written communication plan for interacting with parents, students, and the community regarding day-to-day expectations.
 - OMSD utilizes School Messenger to make district wide phone calls to families to pass along information.

- Each campus made phone contact with every family it serves to determine their needs in regards to connectivity and devices.
