

AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

The benefit provides:

Up to \$30/month discount for internet service

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guide lines;
- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school break fast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.

TWO STEPS TO ENROLL

Go to **ACPBenefit.org** to submit an application or print out a mail-in application.

Contact Ritter Communications to select an eligible plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Eligible households must both apply for the program and contact Ritter Communications to select a service plan.
