March 20, 2025 at 6 p.m.

- 1. Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance
- 2. Meeting called to order by Board President, Travis Freeman, at 6:00 p.m.
- 3. Motion made by Jason Smith and seconded by Bart Beaver to approve the minutes of the February 20, 2025, regular school board meeting as presented. Motion carried.
- 4. Motion made by Andy McCutcheon and seconded by Jason Smith to approve the Financial Report ending February 28, 2025, Motion carried.
  - a. \$7,727,506.01 ending balance
- 5. Motion made by Andy McCutcheon and seconded by Travis Dixon to approve the support agreement between the Ozark Mountain School District Board of Directors and Kristen Craig Garner, LLC. Motion carried.
- 6. Laura Gross, Searcy County Election Commission, discussed polling options for the upcoming election. A motion was made by Andy McCutcheon and seconded by Donald Morris to table the discussion until after agenda item number nine, while Ms. Gross stepped out to clarify a few things. Motion carried.
- 7. April Middleton and Frances Zemlik presented a proposal to the board regarding the WGES and OMHS PTO. The PTO has requested approval to receive a percentage of the profits set aside from the fall festival each year to create a bear improvement fund. No action taken.

- 8. Student Achievement was informational. Melissa Smith, FBLA sponsor, introduced Makinna Treat and Preston Brown. No action taken.
