1. DISTRICT LEVEL STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Based on the district's 2025 Atlas data, the percentage of students who were identified as Level I for the district is 41% in math and 27% in literacy.

- The performance target will be to decrease that percentage by 5% each of the next two years.
- Based on the current Atlas data, the performance target for math will be to decrease the number of students identified as Level I by 5% each of the next two years.

2. DISTRICT/SCHOOL LEVEL GRADUATION RATE

The performance target will be to maintain or exceed the current graduation rate of 96%.

3. SCHOOL (BUILDING) LEVEL ACHIEVEMENT FOR EACH "C" SCHOOL

- The performance target for reading and math, for each elementary school, using STAR data, will be to move 5% of students from the urgent intervention's category (over 1 year below grade level performance) to the intervention's category (6-11 months below grade level performance) or higher, each year by SY 25-26.
- The performance target for reading and math, for each elementary school, using STAR data, will be to move 5% of students to the benchmark (current grade level equivalency) category, each year by SY 25-26.
- The same performance targets will be used for the High School as well.

Failure of the Superintendent to meet any performance target is not a material breach of this agreement but will be reviewed by the Board during the Superintendent's annual evaluation.
